Rules

- The operation of the Lotto will include a weekly draw based on the selection of 4 numbers from 26 numbers i.e. - numbers 1 to 26.
- The subscription is €12.50 per month Direct Debit or cash in advance or one annual payment of €150.
- Each subscriber will be registered and will be allocated a unique registration number. All paid-up registered subscribers:
 - Have 3 choices of 4 numbers
 - Have 3 chances every week of winning the Jackpot of €1,000, or the Match First 3 Prize of €300
 - Are entered in the Weekly Draw for €150
- Any paid up subscribers who matches all 4 numbers drawn will win or share the Jackpot Prize. A subscriber who wins or shares the Jackpot Prize in any week will not be eligible for the Match First 3 Prize in the same week.
- Any paid up subscriber who matches the first three numbers drawn will win or share €300.
- The Jackpot is guaranteed at a minimum of €1,000 per week.
- If there is no Jackpot winner in any week, the Jackpot will be carried forward to the following week. Each week a Jackpot is carried forward, the Jackpot prize will be increased by €1,000. This will ensure a total Jackpot payout of €52,000 during the year.
- To comply with the terms of our permit the maximum payout in any one week will be €10,000. If the accumulative jackpot is over €10,000 the surplus will be brought forward and added to the jackpot the following week.
- In the event of more than one winner, the Jackpot will be divided equally. Prizes will be paid out within ten days of the Draw.
- Persons under 18 years of age are not eligible to participate.
- A full set of rules may be inspected in the Club. The Committee's decision is Final on all matters relating to the Lotto.



- €2 tickets (3 for €5) entitling the holder to one chance for the weekly Jackpot and Match three prizes will be sold. The ticket is not eligible for any of the other draws.
- The lotto will run for a 12 month period from date of commencement. To facilitate the administration of the direct debit payment option we will re use the mandate for future years. If you do not wish to continue just advise the club in writing.
