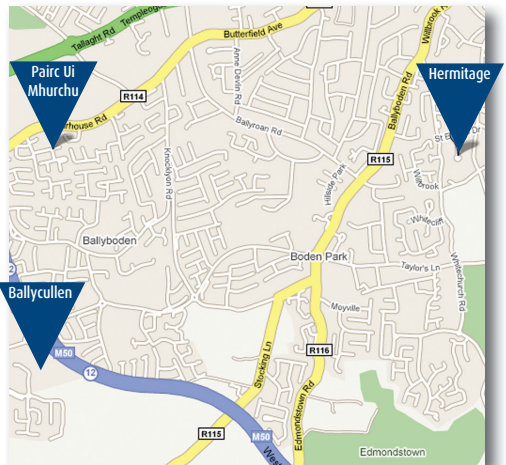

- In an effort to develop the childrens all round sporting ability Ballybodens Academies will incorporate both Hurling/Football for boys & Camogie/Ladies Football for girls.
- The Child:Coach ratio is 1:7. In order to maintain this ratio it is essential that parents become involved in their child's development and if possible assist with the coaching each Saturday and to become part of the club.
- As part of the registration fee **2010 & 2011** children will receive their own **Hurley & Football** for which to practice with and use every Sat. All other equipment such as Helmets, sliotars etc are provided free of charge for **2011** children. This is also the case for **2010** children **EXCEPT** for Helmets, as all **2010** children must have their own Helmet. All **2009** children must have **their own Hurley & Helmet**.
- As part of the registration fee **2010 & 2011** children will receive their own **Academy Jersey**. Children will receive this jersey by the end of Sept / early Oct.
- Please note that children should attend the academy closest to where they live & **parents should car pool or walk to the pitches where possible**.
